3. What is the "victory" mentioned in vv. 54, 55, and 57? What, specifically, has Jesus defeated (see v. 56)? How did Jesus defeat these things?
4. Paul quotes from Isaiah 25:8 in this passage. Why do you think this is important? How does today's main Scripture passage (which is in the New Testament) teach us to read and interpret the Old Testament?
5. What is the "mystery" that Paul refers to in v. 51? Why might God have chosen to not reveal this mystery to those living in Old Testament times?
6. Do you agree with the statement, "You're not ready to live until you're ready to die"? Why or why not?
7. How does this passage give you hope? How does it motivate you?
