6. If God promises to avenge all acts of evil, and we, ourselves, only escape His righteous vengeance because of the sacrificial death of Christ, do we ever have a right to retaliate against those who have wronged us? Why or why not? How should we react when someone wrongs us?
7. Have you ever been disillusioned by discovering something unsavory about one of your heroes? When? If you were ever elevated to the status of "hero," is there anything people could discover about your life that would be just as unsettling?
