## Isaiah 1:2, 4b

<sup>2</sup> Hear me, you heavens! Listen, earth! For the Lord has spoken: “I reared children and brought them up, but they have rebelled against me.



## Isaiah 1:2, 4b

<sup>4b</sup> They have forsaken the Lord; they have spurned the Holy One of Israel and turned their backs on him.

## Isaiah 1:21, 23

<sup>21</sup> See how the faithful city has become a prostitute! She once was full of justice; righteousness used to dwell in her—  
but now murderers!

## Isaiah 1:21, 23

<sup>23</sup> Your rulers are rebels, partners with thieves;  
they all love bribes and chase after gifts.  
They do not defend the cause of the fatherless;  
the widow's case does not come before them.

<sup>29</sup> “You will be ashamed because of the sacred oaks in which you have delighted; you will be disgraced because of the gardens that you have chosen.


## Isaiah 1:24-25a





with the harp and the sound of singing,


## Psalm 98:4-9
